Spend the day at the festival enjoying Irish music, dance and food . . . then join us in the Ceili Dance Tent* from 6:00 to 7:15 pm as we share our joy of contra dance with festival-goers. At 6:00 sharp, experienced contra dancers will hit the floor to perform ONE demo dance, then **Kate Power** will invite new dancers to join us on the dance floor as **Boys of the Hock** play hot Irish jigs and reels!

August 2-4: This 3-day festival offers seven stages featuring Irish music and dance: Altan, Gaelic Storm, Slide, We Banjo Three, Scythian, Socks in the Frying Pan; plus local favorites Changeling, Wild Rumpus, Lone Raven, Brigid's Cross, Hardtackers, Ladies of Longford, Charlene Adzima, Rick Nelson, Killashandra. . . and many more**. Set on 26 rolling acres, it is one of the nation's premiere Irish festivals and a central Ohio tradition. The festival is held in Dublin's Coffman Park, located just northwest of the I-270 outerbelt near the Rt. 161/33 exit. *[Note: Paid Festival admission is required on Saturdays; discounted full weekend passes are available in advance online. If you can only attend Saturday if the admission is waived, email kate@powerkate.com for a one-day pass to participate in the Contra Dancing on Saturday.]*

*The Ceili Dance Tent is located just inside the EAST gate to the festival, at Emerald Parkway and Coffman Park Drive. (Parking lots and shuttles in the area.) Maps on the website.
